

Unity Credit Union *Photo Contest 2019*

1. Unity Credit Union is hosting a photo contest. Members can submit local scenery photographs, for a chance to have their artwork featured on the walls of Unity Credit Union.
2. This promotion will run from Monday, April 15th – Friday, May 31st, 2019. The promotion duration is subject to change without notice.
3. Voting will take place following May 31st, and winners will be announced in June.
4. The winners will have their photographs printed on canvas and hung at Unity Credit Union on display.
5. To enter the contest, Participants must email their photos to marketing@unitycu.ca. Participants must include their full name and the location the photo was taken.
6. High quality JPEG/JPG file format is preferred.
7. We are requesting photos that adhere to the following guidelines and stipulations:
 - a. Photos must include scenery (all seasons are welcome).
 - b. Photos should NOT include people.
 - c. Photos must be taken in the local area of Unity, Saskatchewan.
8. Must be a member of Unity Credit Union to win.
9. Each member can submit a maximum of 10 photos.
10. By entering the contest and submitting photos to Unity Credit Union, members agree to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Unity Credit Union has the right to reproduce the photos to their discretion (size, format, colour, etc.)
 - b. The photos will not be accompanied with any nameplates or titles indicating who the photographer is. Photographers are welcome to use name stamps or watermarks on their photographs, but these must be included at the time of submission.
 - c. Unity Credit Union has the right to hang the photographs in their building indefinitely.
 - d. Unity Credit Union has the right to choose the location where the photos will hang inside the building.
11. Unity Credit Union accepts no responsibility and will not be liable for entries that are not received, incomplete, late, misdirected or illegible for whatever reason, including without limitation, due to computer or other system interruption, malfunction, or breakdown of any kind or duration, network hacking or tampering.
12. Employees, directors and any family members living in their immediate household are eligible for this promotion.
13. Unity Credit Union reserves the right, at its option, to publish the winner's name, address, photograph, likeness, voice or statements without the permission of or further compensation to the winner.
14. The Participant hereby agrees to fully indemnify and hold harmless Unity Credit Union and its officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, representatives, legal representatives, successors and assigns (herein after called "the Indemnified Parties") and each of them from and against any and all claims, liabilities, obligations, losses, damages or costs, including legal costs as between a solicitor and his own client, incurred or suffered by the Indemnified Parties or any of them in connection with or arising out of:
 - a. any injuries, losses or damages (herein after collectively called "the Damages") incurred or suffered by the Participant arising out of the promotion but not restricted to injuries, losses or damages to the person or the property of the Participant or third parties; and
 - b. any claims, action or causes of action commenced or pursued by or on behalf of the Participant in connection with or arising out of the Damages; whether or not the damages arose out of or in connection with breach of contract, negligence, accident or otherwise on the part of the Indemnified Parties, or any of them.
15. The Participant hereby waives and discharges the Indemnified Parties and each of them for any and all:
 - a. liabilities or obligations of the Indemnified Parties or any of them to the Participant in connection with or arising out of the Damages; and
 - b. claims, actions or causes of action that the Participant has or may have against the Indemnified Parties or any of them in connection with or arising out of the Damages.

The Participant acknowledges that the Participant has assumed any and all risks associated with any and all dangers or hazardous conditions which may be encountered arising out of the promotion and the Participant agrees that the Indemnified Parties shall be under no obligation or liability to provide the member with notice of such dangerous or hazardous conditions.
17. Any words in this release and Indemnity which refer to the singular number also shall include the plural number and vice versa.
18. This release and Indemnity shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Saskatchewan.
19. This release and indemnity shall be binding upon the Participant and his or her heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns.
